RHET is known as an essential organisation providing resources and services to support teaching and learning on food and farming, natural environment and working countryside.



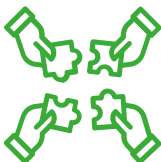
All Children, Young People and Teachers

Driving and supporting collaborative partnerships and networks to support delivering shared goals, extending our reach, voice and engagement.



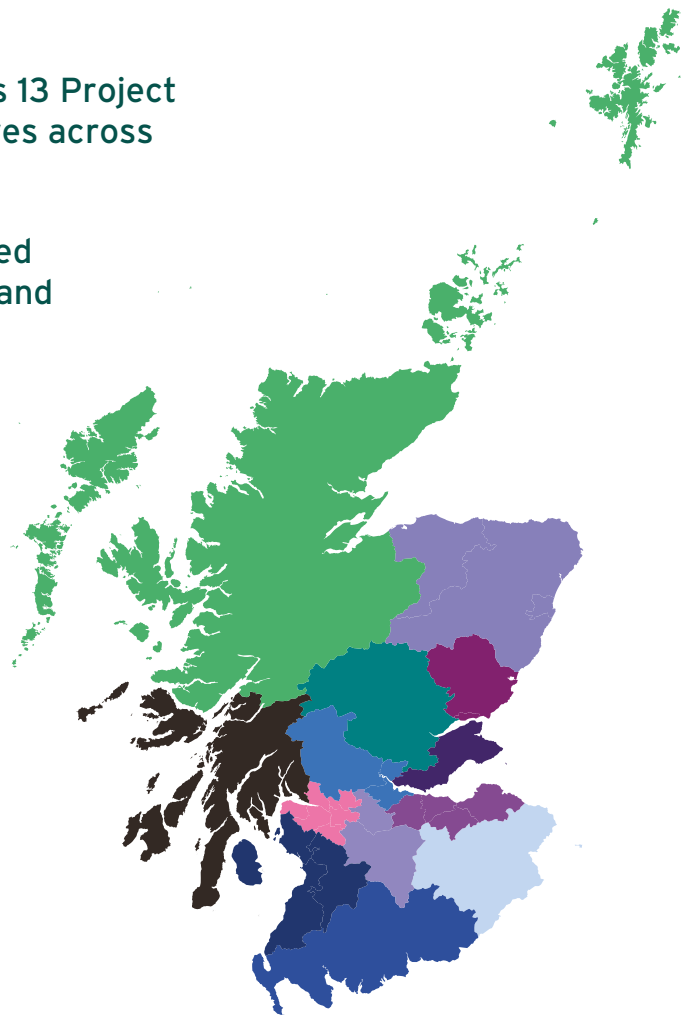
Creating a Sense of Belonging
